Kinsight has an opening for a **full-time Supported Child Development Consultant** for the Tri-Cities and New Westminster. The Supported Child Development Consultant is responsible for assisting families to meet the childcare and individual support needs of children and youth who require additional support and utilize in-own home and/or licensed child care. This position works primarily with families with children 13 years and older using an In-Own-Home model. In collaboration with families, you will develop an Individual Support Plan that will encourage the youth's development and inclusion within the context of their daily routines and resources. You will also support families and youth in the transition from high school to adulthood.

Summary of Qualifications

- A degree from a University or College of recognized standing in a field related to Supported Child Development (e.g. education, child and youth care, social work, psychology), with emphasis on school age children and youth.
- Minimum 3 years experience facilitating a process of individual planning for children and youth who require additional support, and their families, in a variety of inclusive community settings and experience with home visiting.
- High level of understanding with regard to the development of school age children and youth and the impact of disability and delay on growth and development.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills (written and verbal, including record keeping, reporting, facilitation, presentation and public speaking skills); ability to work as an effective team member and demonstrated practical experience in exercising independent judgment and initiative.
